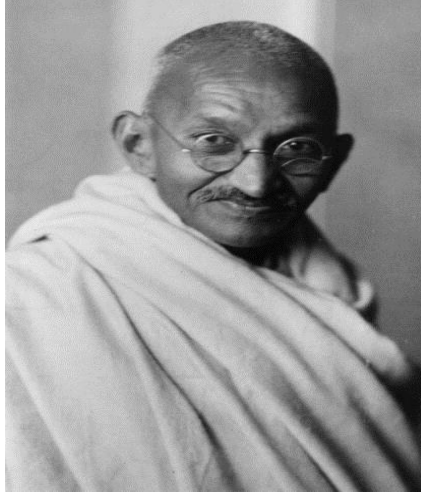
अन्धविश्वास-खण्डन व बोध-

“देखो, जब कोई प्राणी मरता है तब उसका जीव पाप-पुण्य के वश होकर परमेश्वर की व्यवस्था से सुख-दुःख के फल भोगने के अर्थ जन्मान्तर धारण करता है । क्या इस अविनाशी परमेश्वर की व्यवस्था का कोई भी नाश कर सकता है ? अज्ञानी लोग वैद्यकशास्त्र का पदार्थ विद्या के पढ़ने, सुनने और विचार से रहित होकर सन्निपात ज्वरादि शारीरिक और उन्मादादि मानस रोगों का नाम भूत-प्रेतादि धरते हैं । उनका औषधसेवन और पथ्यादि उचित व्यवहार न करके उन धूर्त, पाखण्डी, महामूर्ख, अनाचारी, स्वार्थी---आदि पर भी विश्वासी होकर अनेक प्रकार के ढोंग, छल, कपट, उच्छिष्ट भोजन, डोरा, धागा आदि मिथ्या मंत्र, यन्त्र बांधते-बन्धवाते फिरते हैं, अपने धन का नाश, सन्तानादि की दुर्दशा और रोगों को बढ़ाकर दुख देते फिरते हैं । जब आंख के अन्ध और गांठ के पूरे उन दुर्वुद्धि, पापी, स्वार्थियों के पास जाकर पूछते हैं कि “ महाराज ! इस लड़का, लड़की, स्त्री और पुरुष को क्या हो गया है ? तब वे बोलते हैं कि ‘ इसके शरीर में बड़ा भूत , प्रेत, भैरव, शीतला आदि देवी आ गयी हैं, जब तक तुम इसक उपाय न करोगे तब तक ये न छूटेंगे और प्राण भी ले लेंगे । जो तुम मलीदा वा इतनी भेंट दो तो हम मंत्र-जप, पुनश्चरण से झाड़ इनको निकाल दें । तब वे अन्धे (अन्धविश्वासी) और उनके सम्बन्धी बोलते हैं कि महाराज ! चाहे हमारा सर्वस्व ले जाओ, परन्तु इसको अच्छा कर दीजिये । तब तो उनकी बन पड़ती है । वे धूर्त कहते हैं ‘ लाओ इतनी सामग्री, इतनी दक्षिणा, देवता को भेंट और ग्रहदान कराओ ’ । झांझ,

मृदंग, ढोल, थाली लेके उसके सामने बजाते गाते और उनमें से एक पाखण्डी उन्मत्त होके (शराबादि नशा भी करते हैं) नाच कूद कर कहता है, ' मैं इसका प्राण ही ले लूँगा' तब वे अन्धे उस भंगी चमार आदि नीच के पगों में पड़ के कहते हैं ' आप चाहे जो लीजिये, इसको बचाइये '। तब वह धूर्त बोलता है ' मैं हनुमान हूँ, लाओ पक्की मिठाई, तेल, सिन्दूर, सवा मन का रोट और लाल लंगोट '। ' मैं देवी वा भैरव हूँ, लाओ पाँच बोतल मद्य, बीस मुर्गी, पाँच बकरे , मिठाई और वस्त्र '। जब वे कहते हैं कि 'जो चाहो सो लो' तब तो वह पागल बहुत नाचने-कूदने लगता है । परन्तु जो कोई वुद्धिमान् उनकी भेंट पाँच जूता, दंडा व चपेटा , लातें मारे तो उनके हनुमान, देवी और भैरव झट प्रसन्न होकर भाग जाते हैं, क्योंकि वह उनका केवल धनादि हरण करने के प्रयोजनार्थ ढोंग है ।

प्रिय पाठकगण, आप इसे पढ़े और मनन-चिन्तन करें । भूत जो बीत गया, प्रेत जो मृतक शरीर अर्थात् जब जीवात्मा शरीर से निकल जाने पर जो शरीर/लाश/ मृतक शरीर आदि अनेक नामों से जाना जाता है, होता है । इसमें डराने या दुःख देने की कोई शक्ति नहीं होती । जीवात्मा अपने कर्मानुसार कोई नया शरीर प्राप्त कर लेता है या मुक्ति में चला जाता है । हनुमान्, देवी, भैरव आदि कोई दुष्ट शक्ति नहीं हैं, ये तो वीरता, शौर्य, आर्यत्व व दिव्यता के प्रतीक अपने समय के महान् पुरुष व हस्तियाँ हैं जिनके नाम व इतिहास से हम वीरता व दिव्यता की प्रेरणा ले सकते हैं अतः हमें इनका सत्य इतिहास पढ़ना चाहिये और श्रेष्ठता की ओर बढ़ने में प्रेरणा लेनी चाहिये । उपरोक्त ऋषि दयानन्द-वचनामृत से आप निश्चय ही आन्धविश्वास व पाखण्ड से बचकर सुख पायेंगे, बस, थोड़ी वुद्धिपूर्वक विचार करें और इन्हें अच्छी तरह समझें ।



मैंने गांधी को आँखो देखा-एक संस्मरण

आज तक मुझे समय नहीं मिला था महात्मा गांधी जी को देखने अथवा उनसे मिलने का, मिला भी तो ऐसे दिन जिस दिन उनका इस संसार में आखरी दिन था ।

सम्वत् १९४८ में मैं दिल्ली के चाबड़ी बाजार में अपने बड़े भाई श्री वेद प्रकाश गुप्ता जी के साथ रहा करता था और वहीं पर श्री शंकर दत्त जी भी रहा करते थे जो कांग्रेस के एक माने हुये व्यक्ति थे । मेरे भाई साहेब की उनसे घनिष्ट मित्रता थी ।

एक दिन महात्मा गांधी जी का लेक्चर सुनने की ईच्छा मेरे मन में उठी, तभी मैंने अपने बड़े भाई से अनुरोध किया और उन्होंने श्री शंकर दत्त जी

को पूछा कि यदि वह मेरे सत्य भाई को किसी दिन उस महान् पुरुष से मिलवा लायें । ज्योंहि भाई साहेब ने श्री शंकर दत्त जी से कहा, तच्छण वह चलने को तैयार हो गये । मैं भी उत्सुकता से तैयार हो गया और श्री शंकर दत्त जी के साथ चलने को कदम से कदम मिलाकर विरला हाऊस की तरफ हो लिये । ज्योंहि हम विरला हाऊस पहुँचे, गोलियों के चलने की आवाज सुनाई दी । दरबान गेट बन्द कर ही रहा था परन्तु श्री शंकर दत्त जी को देखते ही शीघ्र अन्दर आने का संकेत किया । १८-२० व्यक्ति गांधी जी का लेक्चर सुनने आये हुये थे । हम सबने मिलकर उस महान् महात्मा जी को अपने हाथों पर उठाकर विरला हाऊस में ले जाने लगे । मेरे हाथों में महात्मा जी के पांव तथा टांगें थे । उस समय कुछ महात्मा जी के लहु के छींटे मेरे पायजामे पर पड़े । मेरे हाथों पर भी उनके टांगों का लहु लग गया था । उस समय कुछ भी परबाह न करते हुये हम सभी विरला हाऊस पहुँचे ।

महात्मा जी के शरीर को विरला हाऊस के अन्दर कमरे में पृथिवी पर लेटा दिया । कुछ ही क्षणों में पं. जवाहर लाल नेहरू, सरदार बल्लभभाई पटेल, श्री राजेन्द्र प्रसाद जी और सभी बड़े-बड़े नेता गण उस स्थान पर पहुँच गये । हम सब से उन नेताओं ने बाहर जाने के लिये अनुरोध किया और हम सब धीरे-धीरे बाहर आ गये । वह सायंकाल का समय था और सभी बाहर की खिड़कियों से झांकते रहे । कुछ ही क्षणों में बाहर भीड़ एकत्र हो गयी । कुछ व्यक्ति धाड़े मार-मार कर रो रहे थे कि कहीं उनमें से या उनके किसी व्यक्ति ने तो गोली नहीं चलाई ! गोली चलाने वाला व्यक्ति पकड़ा जा चुका था । वह कौन था जिसने ऐसा घिनौना काम किया ? सन्नाटा सा छा गया । रात बहुत होती जा रही थी । इसलिये भीड़ धीरे-धीरे छँटती

गयी ।

एक अजब सा दिन था जिस दिन श्री महात्मा गांधी जी के दाह संस्कार का दिवस था । लाखों की संख्या में झुंड के झुंड जिसमें बुढ़े, बच्चे, स्त्रियाँ तथा हर प्रकार के लोग देखने में आये और श्मशान की ओर बढ़ते चले जा रहे थे । लग रहा था मानो दिल्ली खाली हो रही थी । जगह बहुत उबड़-खाबड़ थी । प्रत्येक व्यक्ति वहाँ पर पहुँचने का प्रयास कर रहा था, जहाँ पर अग्नि प्रज्ज्वलित हो रही थी । कोई भी व्यक्ति अपने-अपने स्थान से हिल न पाया जबतक अग्निदाता वहाँ से लौटे नहीं । बड़े-बड़े सब नेता वहाँ पर विराजमान थे । वह कैसा दिन व समय था ! प्रत्येक व्यक्ति के नेत्रों से गंगा-यमुना बहे जा रही थी । कभी-कभी लगने लगा जैसे जनता किसी मेले से लौट रही है !

वापिसी पर हम तीनों वेद भाई, शंकरदत्त जी और मैं खुद श्मशान से आते हुये वाया जामा मस्जिद, नई सड़क और चावड़ी बाजार से होते हुए अपने घर पहुँचे । श्मशान से वापिसी पर तो जो नजारा देख पाये, वह भी अनिर्वचनीय था । पुरानी दिल्ली की प्रत्येक दुकान बन्द थी, लगा कि दिल्ली की सारी ही दुकानें बन्द थीं । आज तक इतिहास में कभी ऐसा सन्नाटा देखने में नहीं आया था जो उस दिन देख पाये । पाँव थक गये, बहुत दूर भी जाना था फिर भी मानो अपने पाँव को अपने ही कंधों पर रखकर चलते रहे और चलते ही रहे; तब अपने मंजिल; अपना घर चावड़ी बाजार पहुँच गये ।

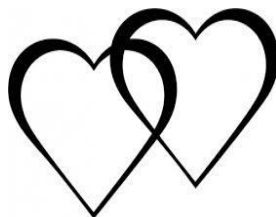
