## **10 Principles of Arya Samaj**

## **Meaning**

**वेद-कथा : विवरण**  
**(२६.०८.२०१८ से २.०९.२०१८)**

**रक्षा-बन्धन, केनोपनिषद्-कथा व कृष्णजन्माष्टमी**

हर वर्ष की भाँति इस वर्ष भी श्रावण मास के प्रारम्भ में रक्षाबन्धन से शुरु कर कृष्णजन्माष्टमी पर वेद कथा का समापन किया गया । प्रवचन कर्त्ता थे- आचार्य डॉ. उमेश यादव-धर्माचार्य-स्थानीय आर्य समाज ।

२६ अगस्त को रक्षाबन्धन पर्व का महत्त्व बताते हुये आचार्य श्री उमेश जी ने वेद कथा के मूल विषय “ केनोपनिषद ” का भी परिचय कराया । रक्षाबन्धन में भाई-बहन के पारस्परिक प्यार, सेवा, सुरक्षा व वृद्धि युक्त व्यवहारों का बढ़ाना है, वैसे ही श्रावण उपाकर्म पर्व पर आचार्य-शिष्य के सम्बन्धों को भी प्यार, सेवा, सुरक्षा, वृद्धि व विशेषकर ज्ञान-वृद्धि को बढ़ाना है । इसके लिये दोनों परस्पर एक-दूजे का ध्यान रखें-ऐसी प्रेरणा दी गयी । इस दिन सत्संगीय यज्ञ-काल में यज्ञोपवीत=जनेऊ भी सबने बदले । इसमें चातुर्मास जो वर्षा ऋतु के हैं, साधु, मुनि, ऋषि, आचार्य आदि विद्वान् को जंगल या आश्रम से आकर ग्राम, नगर व शहर में उपदेश देना सरल होता है । इस प्रकार विद्वान् संसार का भला अपने ठोस

ज्ञान-विज्ञान के प्रचार से किया करते हैं । यही चातुर्मास पर्व है । श्रवण=सुनना और स्रवन= जल का वरसना दोनों का कितना ताल-मेल है । जल वरसने से यातायात रुक सा जाता है और विद्वान् इस कारण शुरु में ही आकर नगर आदि वेद-प्रचार की योजना बना लेते हैं । भौतिक रूप से जल-वर्षा और आध्यात्मिक रूप से ज्ञान-वर्षा; यही तो दोनों का सामँजस्य है । पहले दिन में यह सब श्रोता गण को समझाया गया ।

केनोपनिषद्-कथा- इस वर्ष आचार्य जी ने बहुत ही सरल भाषा व पद्धति से उपस्थित श्रोताओं को केनोपनिषद् पर हर सायं ७.३० से ८.३० नित्यप्रति व्याख्यान दिया । वीच-वीच में सन्दर्भित भजन भी गाया-गवाया जाता रहा जिससे व्याख्यान और ही रोचक बनता रहा ।

“केन” शब्द से आरम्भ होने के कारण यह उपनिषद् केनोपनिषद् कहलाती है । इसे तवलकारोपनिषद् भी कहते हैं कारण कि यह कथा तवलकार ब्राह्मण ग्रन्थ से ली गयी है । तवल= त-तत् (ईश्वर ), व-जीवात्मा ( वर्तते नित्यं यः स ), ल- लीयते अस्मिन् सर्वं प्रलयकाले अर्थात् प्रकृति । इस प्रकार ईश्वर, जीव व प्रकृति का उचित सम्बन्ध जो बताये वह तवलकार उपनिषद् है; ऐसा आचार्य जी ने अपने प्रवचन में समझाया ।

इसमें कुल ४ खण्ड हैं । प्रत्येक खण्ड पर १.५ दिन अर्थात् १.५ घंटे का व्याख्यान प्रस्तुत करके सब खण्डों के मूल रहस्यों को विस्तार से खोला गया । पहले में थोड़ा ज्ञान, दूसरे में थोड़ा गहरा, तीसरे में ज्ञान-गर्व अर्थात् थोड़ा ऐसे जैसे ज्ञान का घमंड होने लगा है पर चौथे में सब घमंड का पिघल जाना जैसे अनुभूति दर्शायी गयी । सामवेदीय शाखा से निकली गुरु-

शिष्य संवाद है यह । मन, प्राण, चक्षु व श्रोत्र ही को शिष्य गण सब कुछ मान बैठे । केन=किस प्रकार ये इन्द्रियाँ मन व आत्मा आपस में जुड़े हैं, इन्द्रियों से मन बड़ा है, मन से प्राण और आत्मा बड़ा और फिर आत्मा से परमात्मा जो सृष्टि का निर्माता है; जीवनदाता है और सर्वज्ञाता है; बड़ा है । विस्तार ज्ञान के लिये केनोपनिषद् पढ़ें और विद्वान् आचार्य से शंका समाधान करें तो निश्चित ही इसका आपको भी सम्यग् बोध होगा ।

यह सायंकालीन कथा १ सितम्बर २०१८ तक चली जो अत्यन्त रोचक व ज्ञान वर्धक रही । अंतिम दिन मान्य प्रधान डॉ. नरेन्द्र कुमार ने सब श्रोताओं व प्रवचनकर्त्ता आचार्य श्री को हार्दिक धन्यवाद यापन किया । यह कथा-कार्यक्रम भी उन्हीं के निवेदन से प्रारम्भ हुआ था । वीच-वीच में सुश्री सुमन भारद्वाज ने केले आदि का परसाद भी बाँटा । सभी उपस्थित होने वाले श्रोताओं में लगातार ही अधिक से अधिक सुनने की रुचि बनी रही ।

२ सितम्बर २०१८ रविवार के सत्संगकाल में आचार्य जी ने योगीराज कृष्ण के जीवन पर प्रकाश डाला और एक बहुत ही सारगर्भित कविता भी कृष्ण जी के वैदिक जीवन पर आधारित सुनायी जो आचार्य जी द्वारा ही रचित कविता थी ।

इस प्रकार यहाँ कृष्ण जन्माष्टमी भी मनायी गयी । योगी राज कृष्ण के चरित्रों को जीवन में ढालना ही उनका सच्चा आदर है; ऐसा कहा गया ।

## **PANCHMAHAYAJNA**

Till now we have written about 1. **Sandhyopaasanam (Brahma-Yajna)** and 2. **Deva- Yajna**. Now we will write about the remaining three Yajna. These are called 3. **Balivaishvadeva Yajna**, 4. **Pitri Yajna** and 5. **Atithi Yajna**.

**3. BALIVAISHVADEVA YAJNA - The aim of this Yajna is to provide food and water for the animals like birds, dogs, cats and insects etc. It is a duty of all human beings to care for animals as well.**

This Yajna is performed by the cook after he/she has finished cooking. He/she offers ten oblations of unsalted cooked food in the burning fire of a fire place in the kitchen. If daily Havan is performed or whenever Havan is performed in the household then Yajman can offer these ten oblations in Havan Kund after the final oblation (Purna Aahuti). These ten oblations are as following.

1. Om Agneya Swaaha. 2. Om Somaaya Swaaha. 3. Om Agnisomaabhyaam Swaaha. 4. Om Vishvebhyo Devebhyah Swaaha. 5. Om Dhanvantaraye Swaaha. 6. Om Kuhvai Swaaha. 7. Om Anumatyai Swaaha. 8. Om Prajaapataye Swaaha. 9. Om sah Dhyavaaprithvibhyaam Swaaha. 10. Om Swishtakrite Swaaha.

Maharishi Dayanand Saraswati has instructed to keep portions of food in different directions on a broad tree leaf (Pattal) or a large flat mettalic plate (Thaali) after reciting following Mantras.

- 1. Om Saanugaayendraaya Namah. - Towards East**
- 2. Om Saanugaaya Yamaaya Namah. - Towards South**
- 3. Om Saanugaaya varunaaya Namah. - Towards West**
- 4. Om Saanugaaya Somaaya Namah. - Towards North**
- 5. Om Marudbhyo Namah. - Towards door of the house**
- 6. Om Adabhyo Namah. - In Water**
- 7. Om Vanaspatibhyo Namah. - In Pesal (Musal) and Mortar (Ukhal)**

8. Om Shriyai Namah. - Towards North - Eastern corner
9. Om Bhadrakaalyai Namah.-Towards South - West corner
10. Om Brahmapatye/Brama Namah. - In the Middle
11. Om Vaastupataye Namah. - In the Middle
12. Om Vishvebhyo Devebhyo Namah. - Towards up
13. Om Vivaacharebhyo Bhutebhyo Namah. - Towards up
14. Om Naktachaaribhyo Bhutebhyo Namah- Towards up
15. Om Sarvaatmabhutaye Namah. - Towards back
16. Om Pitribhyah Svadhaayibhyah Svadhaa Namah. - In South again.

Towards the end a person should put six portions of food items, made of various cereals in Ghee and salt, on earth for the benefit of dogs, depraved people, wicked people, people in habit of committing sins on a regular basis, crow and insects. This act is supported by Manusmriti 3.92.

**Shunaam Cha Patitaanaam Cha Shwapachaam Paaproginaam.  
Vaayasaanaam Kriminaam Cha Shankairnirvaped Bhuvi.**

**4. Pitri Yajna-** This Yajna is about making people understand and remember their duties towards their parents. We do not offer any oblation in this Yajna.

**To obey our parents and elders while they are alive, to serve them the best way we can, to learn from their knowledge and experience and to respect them all the time is known as Pitri Yajna. To serve one's parents to their full satisfaction with great respect and devotion while they are alive is the best Shraaddh and Tarpan. Shraaddh performed under guidance of some greedy Pauranic Pundits after the death of one's parents is totally against the teachings of Vedas. Shraaddh and Tarpan regarding dead people as written in Pauranic books does not serve any purpose towards dead people. But these acts against teachings of Vedas can be harmful to relatives regarding waste of their valuable time and money. After death a soul either**

**enters inside the physical body of a newly born animal or human or achieves Salvation according to the deeds of the dead person. This aspect is already written in detail under Cremation Sacrament.**

**It is paramount duty of all human beings to serve their parents and teachers with full respect and devotion.**

**5. Atithi Yajna-** This yajna is another about making people understand, aware and remember their duties towards guests (Atithi). We do not offer any oblation in Havan Kund in this yajna. Similar to our parents who brought us in this world we are all indebted to our teachers, Acharya, Rishis and Maharishis who are not biased, live life with dignity, speak truth and who are devout, religious and intelligent. These kind of people help us in living a good and successful life by imparting their knowledge and experience to us.

**So to obey them, to serve them with full respect and devotion is our duty.**

**Brahmachari, Vanprasthi and Sanyasi people can come/turn up to a Grihasthi (Household) person's house at any time with or without a prior information. Even in these circumstances we must serve them with full respect and devotion. This is a true Atithi Yajna.**
